

Fit Sample Event Worksheet

Use a controlled try-on to record product-specific decisions before the final size allocation is approved.

Event setup

Organization	Team, club, shop or program.	
Coordinator	Person controlling the sample kit and final allocation.	
Sample purpose	Fit-only, material review, appearance review or other decision.	
Products included	List exact product names and fit directions.	
Review date / location	Where and when the controlled fitting occurred.	

Try-on procedure

| 01 | Use the actual product family; do not translate a size label automatically from another jersey, bib or rider pattern. | [] |
| 02 | Review in riding posture and with intended base layers or equipment. | [] |
| 03 | Check shoulder and torso reach, sleeve or strap behavior, hem or gripper position, pocket access and comfort. | [] |
| 04 | Record the exact product and size per rider, plus any layering or exception note. | [] |
| 05 | Keep samples controlled, follow handling instructions and record every item returned. | [] |
| 06 | Freeze the final size allocation through the authorized coordinator before commercial release. | [] |
